About Us

- With a population of around 500 people, Pyramid Hill is a quaint rural farming town situated 90 kms north of Bendigo.
- Pyramid Hill is renowned for its namesake, a stunning granite hill rising 187m above sea level in the mostly flat terrain of the area.
- Our school was founded by the Josephite Sisters in 1956 as a memorial to the men and women of the district who lost their lives in WWII.
- St. Patrick's School has a high proportion of Filipino students whose families have moved to Australia in recent years contributing to the rich culture of our community.
- Learning happens in one collaborative classroom setting with 18 students from Foundation to Year 6 with two full-time classroom educators. A specialist teacher visits one day per fortnight to teach Art & Craft and Cooking.
- The Parish and the School work closely together and celebrate many masses, liturgies and occasions throughout the year.
