

Sandhurst Catholic Education Office Strategic Plan 2017-2020

The Sandhurst Catholic Education Office (CEO) Strategic Plan has been developed through a consultative, iterative process, April-September, 2016. This Strategic Plan is placed within the context of the Review of Catholic Education Office, Diocese of Sandhurst, July 2016, Stakeholders Report.

The CEO Leadership Team will prioritise and action the Review recommendations.

Within this context, the Strategic Plan, seeks to connect with and ensure implementation of the Review's recommendations.

Our Catholicity and our relationship with God is central to our work. We look to a service model, where all persons are valued and empowered to be their best.

The centrality of the Charter of Sandhurst School Improvement, (CoSSI) is at the heart of this endeavour.

"At the heart of CoSSI is the focus on relationships – the who of learning as well as the what of learning. O'Leary inspires CoSSI reminding us that 'the task of the educator is to bring all students to the edge of their own divine possibilities for recognising the divine everywhere.... for every human experience is a threshold to God."

The CEO Team will present a student-centred service provision model.

This model places value and importance on the relationships, partnerships and collaboration which occurs between CEO staff and wider parish communities.

The service model is one based on the guiding principles of *Mission*, *Stewardship*, *Dialogue*, *Subsidiarity* and *Co-responsibility*.

The CEO Team recognises, with respect, the need to be flexible, adapt to the signs of the times and respond to the context for the benefit of all students.

This Strategic Plan is for the period 2017-2020, with review in 2020.
